1.0 Executive Summary

CDDA Filesystem is a Mac OS X Virtual File System (VFS) kernel extension that allows the user to insert Audio CDs, mount them on their Desktop, and use drag-and-drop to copy the audio files from the CD to their system.

2.0 Requirements

2.1 Allow the user to insert an Audio CD and have it mount on the desktop

2.2 Drag and drop of files from Audio CD volume to other volumes results in a file that can be played in QuickTimeX, Finder QuickLoop preview, iTunes, and most other third party audio playback applications.

2.3 Seamless integration with iTunes/CDDB so that Audio CDs that have been catalogued by iTunes show up with catalogued names in Finder and other applications.

2.4 Localized track names for default track and album titles

2.5 Support for Mixed-Mode CDs, Enhanced CDs, Pre-Gap CDs, and combination Video CD/Audio CDs.
